Each year, Yale faculty, students, and alumni participate in the annual U.N. climate conference, or COP, sharing research and working with delegations from around the world. This year the contingent at COP27 in Egypt included 25 Yale School of the Environment (YSE) students and six undergraduates working with NGOs and government organizations. Dr. Anthony Leiserowitz, director of the [Yale Program on Climate Change Communication](#), presented results from surveys of public opinion about climate change in 110 countries. We also introduced emerging environmental leaders to YSE's newly launched [Three Cairns Climate Program for the Global South](#). Yale's leadership continues to expand as more people from across our community focus on developing innovative, equitable climate solutions.
