New Research Bridges the Gap in Understanding NO₂ Exposure Disparities



YPS had the opportunity to interview Dr. Lingzhi Chu, a postdoctoral associate at the Yale School of Public Health and lead author on a paper published in *One Earth* this July. Dr. Chu explained findings on the health impacts of nitrogen dioxide (NO₂) exposure and disparities across different demographic segments, and shared a new research brief for policymakers created by the Yale Center for Climate Change and Health. Liming Can Help Enhance Carbon Capture in Agricultural Fields



A Yale-led study published in *Nature Water* found that adding crushed limestone to agricultural fields can remove tons of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere each year while improving crop yields. Researchers at the Yale Center for Natural Carbon Capture (YCNCC) explain how calcium carbonate works as a valuable resource in fighting climate change. [Read more.](#)
